

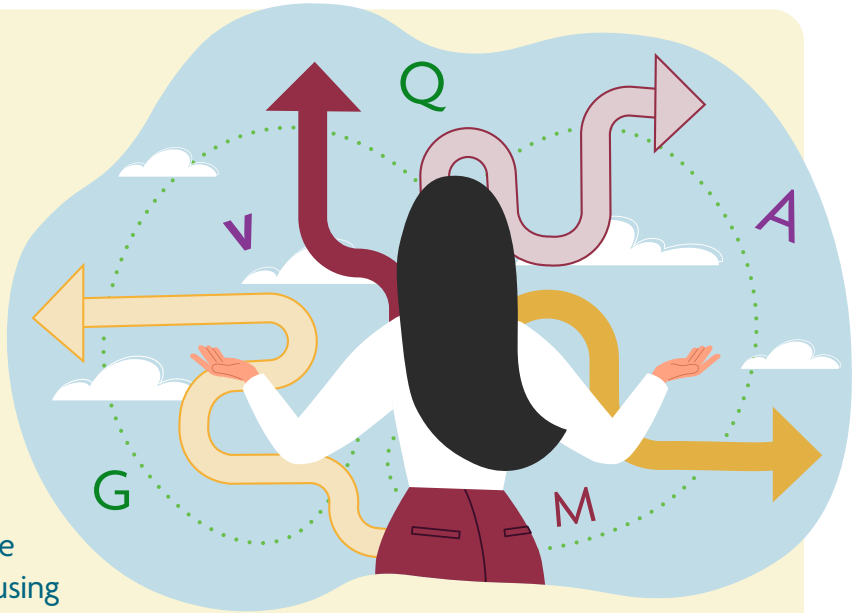
Confused by an Acronym?

An acronym is the first letters of each word in a title or phrase.

Example:

FYJP = Family and Youth Justice Programs

Acronyms are often used by courts and state agencies to save time, but they can be confusing if you don't know what they mean.
