- Assistance in accessing contracted In-Home Services
- Assistance in exploring resources for outpatient mental health support for your child, family, or you, as the parent
- Renegotiating monthly maintenance payments based on changes in your child's needs or the circumstances of your family
- Opening or closing medical coverage when you move to a new state
- One-time financial support if your family faces hardship due to an unforeseen family situation (up to \$1500.00)
- Promoting & Supporting Permanency Committee funds
- Informal referrals to other services and supports outside our scope of work
