Case Plans are written with the family to set goals that keep the child safe and support well-being in the future.

Service Plans list the services that are recommended, court-ordered, or agreed to by the family. These services help build skills, strengthen protective factors, and support family well-being.

Safety Plans are short-term agreements made with the family and their supports to handle immediate safety threats to the child. A Safety Plan is only needed if a safety threat exists.

Case plans are to start with the family within 15 days of caseworker assignment and prior to DCYF making a service referral. They should be finalized within 45 days, reviewed monthly, and modified as needed.
