## Purpose

The purpose of this memo is to provide guidance to Child Welfare (CW) employees of the updated policy and procedure requirements to align with <u>House Bill 1227: Keeping Families</u> <u>Together Act</u> and <u>KW</u> Supreme Court decision.

This policy is under full review for further revisions, but the following changes will take effect July 1, 2023:

## **New Procedural Requirements**

Caseworkers must:

- Conduct a universal domestic violence (DV) screening prior to placing in a relative or suitable person's home and document in a case note.
- Conduct a specialized DV assessment If there is domestic and/or intimate partner violence identified and document in a case note.
- If the child or youth's safety is in question, staff with your supervisor to determine if a Safe Child Consultation is appropriate to:
  - Mitigate the concerns.
  - Develop a Placement Support Plan.
