Dear Early Intervention Providers,

As most of you are aware, the anticipated shift of funding for Early Support for Infants and Toddlers (ESIT) is delayed for one year. This delay is due to prerequisite legislative action related to state apportionment of B-2 funding. The funding shift will require more changes than anticipated to the special education portion of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 28A.155 as well as additions to the Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) RCW.

A <u>proviso</u> was included in the state budget and describes next steps and caps on administrative withholding. For more information, please refer to the <u>Delayed Funding Shift Q&A</u>. In order to meet ESIT's goal of maximizing available resources for early intervention, DCYF will continue to engage in conversations with the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) and other partners about current and future special education (B-21) state appropriations.
