Early Support for Infants and Toddlers Proviso

The Department of Children, Youth, and Families, in consultation with the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Office of Financial Management, and the Caseload Forecast Council must develop a proposal to transfer the annual allocations appropriated in the Omnibus Appropriations Act for early intervention services for children with disabilities from birth through two years of age, from the Superintendent of Public Instruction to the Department of Children, Youth, and Families beginning July 1, 2020.

The Department of Children, Youth, and Families must submit a model detailing how allocations for this program will be determined and identifying the necessary statutory changes to the Office of Financial Management and the Fiscal Committees of the Legislature no later than September 1, 2019.

Beginning July 1, 2019, there shall be an administrative limit of five percent on all state funds allocated to school districts for early intervention services for children with disabilities from birth through two years of age.
