

Early Support for Infants and Toddlers: Annual State Report Cards FFY 2018 – 2019 (July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019)

The Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF) is the State Lead Agency for the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C program for Washington State. Within DCFY, the Part C programmatic home is the Early Support for Infants and Toddlers (ESIT) program.

During Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2018, the ESIT program held contracts with 24 Local Lead Agencies (LLAs) statewide in order to ensure that all families have equitable access to a locally coordinated system of early intervention services. As a result, 19,647 eligible infants, toddlers and their families received early intervention services during the past year. The types of organizations that administered each local early intervention system included:

- 1 county health district
- 4 county human service agencies
- 1 combined health and human services agency
- 14 nonprofit agencies; and
- 4 educational service districts

To ensure services are coordinated and conform to IDEA Part C requirements, each LLA develops and maintains a local Early Intervention Service (EIS) plans. This plan outlines how services are provided in the LLA designated service area. In addition, LLA's, develop subcontracts and/or local interagency agreements with EIS providers and/or EIS provider agencies within their geographic service area to ensure that no child and family goes unserved.

Annually, each State must report to the public the performance of each EIS program located in the State on the targets in the State Performance Plan (SPP)/Annual Performance Report (APR), including a review of each program's performance against targets in the State's SPP/APR. The following report cards represent Washington State's FFY18 Annual Performance Report data for each LLA.
