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| To develop recommendations regarding improving outcomes for individuals exiting juvenile rehabilitation with a focus on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Increasing community involvement before and after the individual’s exit from a juvenile rehabilitation facility; ▪ A landscape analysis of community-based, reentry-related services available to individuals exiting a juvenile rehabilitation facility by geographic region and service type; ▪ Community-based, reentry-related service gaps that should be addressed to ensure a successful community transition services program across the state. |
