accommodate the July 1, 2021 authorization, the department developed a phased approach under which licensing would						
continue using agreements similar to those used during the pilot while foundational quality standards to include health and safety standards were developed. The department proposed chapter 100-302 WAC Foundational Quality Standards for						
Outdoor Nature-Based Programs under WSR 22-23-072 on November 10, 2022. Once chapter 110-302 WAC is effective,						
chapter 110-300E will not be needed.
