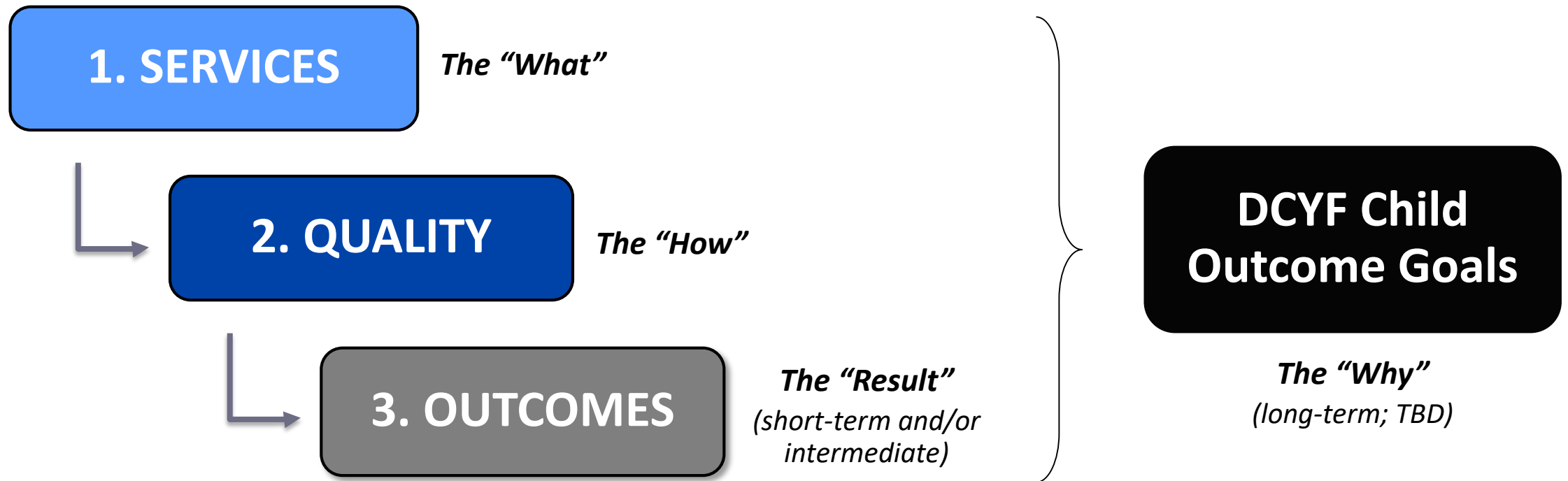

Why Performance-Based Contracting?

- 1. House Bill 1661 requires DCYF to implement performance-based contracting**
 - Focus on *quality* or *outcomes*, and
 - Tie at least a portion of the contractor's payment, extension, or contract renewals to performance
- 2. Opportunity to work with partners to improve child outcomes and reduce disparities**

DCYF Performance-Based Contracting Standards

1. SERVICES

(all contracts by 7/1/19)

Contracts for client services will identify the following minimum deliverables:

- ✓ Services/products to be provided to clients (# and/or description)
- ✓ Report services/products were provided to clients and number of clients served

Report what services/products were provided to each client (*starting July 1, 2019*)

2. QUALITY

(all contracts by 7/1/20)

- ✓ Participate in the development of program-specific quality measures (*FY19 – FY20*)
- ✓ Once identified, contract incorporates quality measures

3. OUTCOMES

(all contracts by 7/1/21)

- ✓ Participate in the development of program-specific quality measures (*FY20 – FY21*)
- ✓ Once identified, contract incorporates outcome measures



Exception for Tribal-Only Agreements*

Based on unique government-to-government relationship, a **temporary exception for FY19 (July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019) applies to tribal-only agreements*** to allow sufficient time to co-create an implementation plan for the PBC standards that addresses the needs of both tribal partners and state legal requirements

- No changes prior to FY20 (July 1, 2019)
- New, renewed, or extended tribal-only agreements for client services executed after July 1, 2018 must expire on or before June 30, 2019

***Agreements exclusively available to federally-recognized tribes**
