
KEY MESSAGES

The most important points we want to share when talking about the Child Care Subsidy program:

- Many Washington families qualify for free or low-cost child care.
- Families can get help applying in multiple languages.
- Families can check their eligibility and apply online or by phone.
- Copays with a child care subsidy are no more than \$165 a month. Some families may even pay nothing.







- Add child care subsidy details to your website, newsletter, or community board.
- Use the provided flyers, social media posts, and email templates to spread the word.
- Display printed materials in high-traffic areas where families can see them.
- Connect with partners and organizations to help amplify this information.
