Supporting Community-Driven Solutions to Reduce Child Maltreatment

Strengthen Families Locally aims to increase family resilience and reduce rates of child maltreatment and entry into foster care in target communities. The Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) will partner with community organizations, schools, families, volunteers and others in local communities to achieve these outcomes. Funded by the Administration for Children and Families, this 5-year project started in 2019. Strengthen Families Locally is located in the Family Support Programs Division at DCYF.

Goals:

DCYF seeks to partner with the community in service areas to:

- 1. Reduce rates of child maltreatment
- 2. Reduce rates of foster care entry
- 3. Eliminate racial disproportionalities in maltreatment and foster care entry

Principles:

- 1. Approaches will be strengths-based, 4. Our work will strengthen culturally appropriate and inclusive
- 2. Mobilization will occur at multiple levels, including state government, local government, local non-profits, schools, families, volunteers, tribes, faith communities, etc., and will occur through a variety of means
