


## DASHBOARD BASICS

"Data dashboards are a summary of different, but related data sets, presented in a way that makes the related information easier to understand. Dashboards are a type of data visualization, and often use common visualization tools such as graphs, charts, and tables."




WHAT GETS TRACKED? Each Performance Based Contract dashboard presents a range of data including your program's metrics and targets. Dashboards are living documents that update at regular intervals with new data and can be adjusted.



## WHY A DASHBOARD?

Dashboards can be used as a continuous improvement tool. They help you and your providers see at a glance progress on key metrics.



WHO HAS ACCESS? Dashboards are password protected and are not public facing. Only program staff and contracted providers will have access to the dashboards.
